Abstract

The researcher has divided the research into four parts, the introduction and three chapters, the first chapter serves as preliminary chapter in which the concept of civilization and the characteristics and domain of Islamic Civilization, the researcher has also elicited the linguistic meaning of civilization and its terms that are used in Holy Quran and in the Islamic and Western visualization. The characteristics of Islamic Civilization, its different domains and its social and economic relations have been mentioned as well. The second Chapter talks about the pillars of civilization construction.
